CREATE WITH US

University Libraries' Experiential Learning team invites any Baylor University community member to apply for a grant to design and build a creative or innovative project using our spaces and equipment. Your project may be curricular or extracurricular, individual or group work, and should be designed to make some positive impact, for community or self. Examples could include a creative thesis, research, prototyping an invention, or solving a community problem. The library hosts audio-visual, immersive media, text-mining, mapping/GIS, CAD modeling, and making resources. Library staff are available for consultation prior to application by visiting the Garden Level of Moody Library or by making an appointment.



GRANT COMMITMENTS

Complete a creative project of your own design that utilizes creative tools, software, and/or equipment.

Receive technical training from the Experiential Learning team. Support may include meeting with a consultant to plan an effective project.

Follow all rules regarding the use and operation of Creative Making and Creative Media spaces and equipment.

Give back to the University Libraries by either leading a workshop, exhibiting your work, or presenting on the process.

GRANT RECIPIENTS RECEIVE

Group and individual support and training in how to effectively use physical and digital making technologies. Support may be available on-site and/or virtually.

Up to \$500 to cover the cost of tools and materials needed to implement this project. Amount dependent on the scope of the assignment.

Access to the Innovation Garage, an exclusive makerspace located in the Baylor Research and Innovation Collaborative. Access to the Innovation Garage will be for a limited duration to coincide with the project timeline.

Opportunity to exhibit your work for a limited time in the University Libraries.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. Describe your project and its purpose.
2. Which tool(s) would you like to use with your project?
3. What materials do you anticipate needing to complete your project?
4. Does this project require a workspace and/or storage area where the project may be left in place safely?
5. Provide an estimated cost for the project. An Experiential Learning team member can you with this task.
6. What degree of support do you require?
7. What is the timeline for completion of the project?
